All funds raised will go directly to UNIFEM.

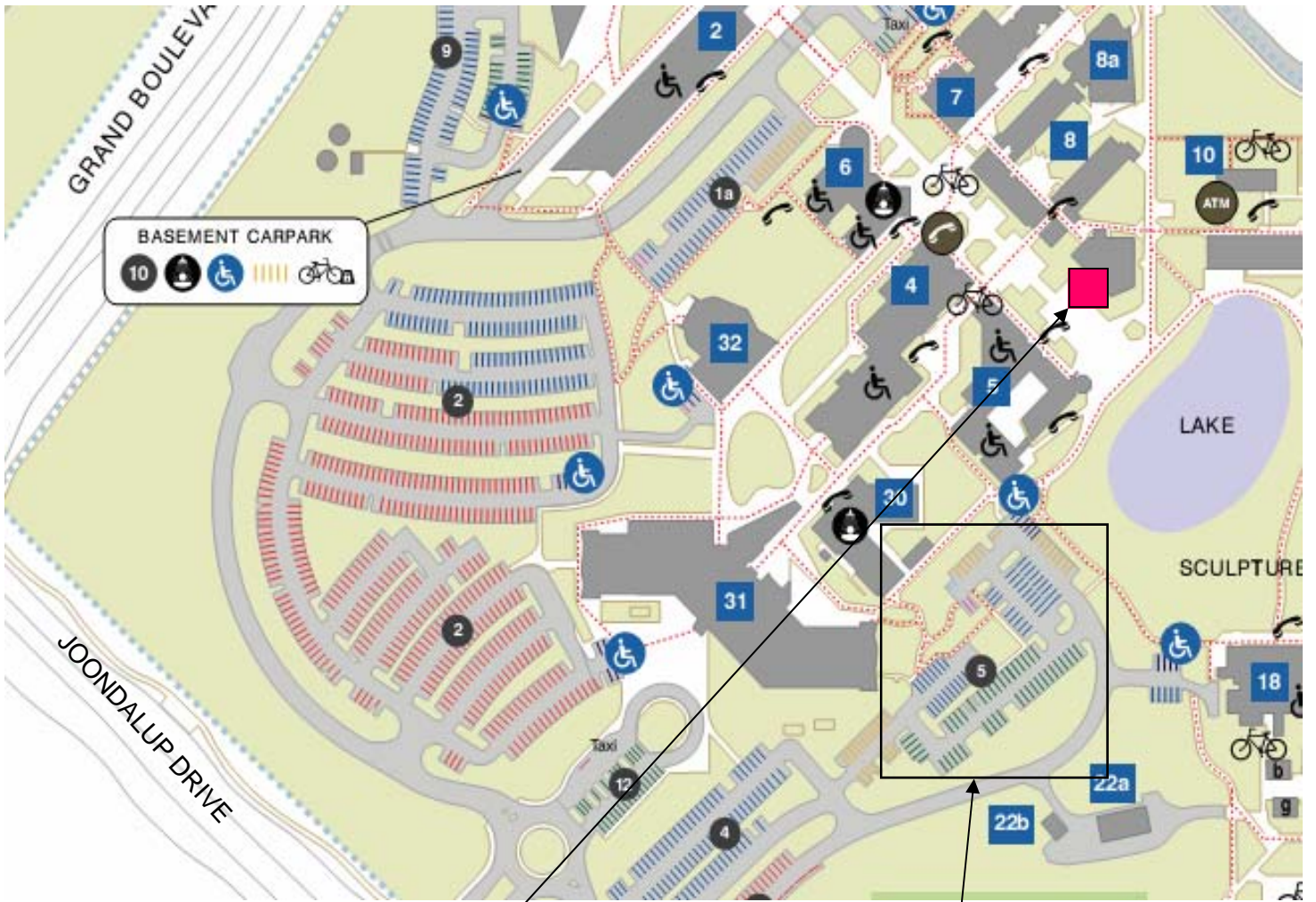
